APPLICATION PROCESS

All individuals must apply no later than April 18, 2025. Applications are available at UMDGC or www.umdgc.com. Interviews for the most highly qualified applicants will be held April 21-25. Current employees of UMDGC/UMAS may express their interest in the position by emailing personnel@umdgc.com in lieu of completing an application. The new position will become effective at a time that is mutually acceptable to the applicant and UMDGC. Additional positions with the gymnastics and tumbling programs may be available.

RECOMMENDED MINIMUM COMMITMENT & COMPENSATION

- 32-35 hours per week, including weekends.
- Starting at \$25/hour. Final rate commensurate upon the employee's experience and additional responsibilities with UMDGC.
- Opportunities for privates during off-peak hours.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS TO APPLY FOR THE POSITION:

- 18 years of age.
- Proficient in using MS Outlook, MS Word, MS Excel, MS Publisher, web browsers, and Windows computers.
- Reliable transportation to and from UMDGC and competitions.
- Ability to confidently spot standing back handsprings and running roundoff back handsprings.

THE FOLLOWING MUST BE ATTAINED WITHIN 30 DAYS OF ACCEPTING THE POSITION:

- Requirements as set forth by Pennsylvania state law for employees working directly with children, if not already in the applicant's possession.

- Experience in coaching tumbling.
- Spotting ability.
